

Transportation Resources for 1285 Beacon Street, 2nd Floor, Brookline, MA

Parking Options

Street parking is available at metered spots on Beacon Street as well as metered and unmetered spots on surrounding streets. Please be aware of any street signage for restrictions.

There are handicap accessible spots in front of the Post Office on Beacon Street, in the center parking on Beacon Street, and on Charles Street perpendicular to Beacon Street.

There are local parking lots and garages in the area including along Harvard Street perpendicular to Beacon Street; these are not affiliated with Mass General Brigham.

Public Transit Options



The following public transportation options exist, distances are calculated from closest stop to 1285 Beacon Street

Bus Routes:

- **MBTA Bus 66** stops on Harvard Street (>0.1 mile)
- **MBTA Bus 65** stops on Washington Street and Beacon Street (0.9 mile)

Train Options

- **Green Line Branch C – Coolidge Corner and Saint Paul Street Stops** on Beacon Street (0.1 mile)
- **Green Line Branch D – Longwood Stop** on Chapel Street (0.6 mile)



The RIDE by the MBTA

THE RIDE paratransit service provides door-to-door, shared-ride transportation to eligible people who cannot use fixed-route transit (bus, subway, trolley) all or some of the time because of a physical, cognitive, or mental disability. The RIDE is available for a fee in and around the Boston community.
